



# Transition out of Lockdown #3 – Checklist

**Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2021**

## **Checklist for Referees & Umpires**

*This checklist has been developed to support Officials 'Transition out of Lockdown #3':*

---

### **MASKS**

1. Masks are mandatory in outdoor public places, except for vigorous outdoor exercise.
  2. Masks are mandatory for indoor public venues and must be worn when entering the clubrooms. This includes, but is not limited to, the toilets, change rooms or canteen.
  3. Children 12 years of age and under are exempt from wearing a face mask.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

1. No spectators are permitted at games. One parent/guardian can assist if their young child requires support, but subject to the 4sqm rule.
  2. Clubrooms, canteen and bars will be closed. Toilets will remain open, but patrons must observe the four metre capacity rule for social distancing.

### **PRE-MATCH**

1. Be aware of the WA Government and Health Department's guidelines. Ensure that teams know of these guidelines by checking with the coach or manager.
  2. Check in using the SafeWA app or manual register.
  3. Do NOT officiate in any matches if you have any flu like symptoms - fever, runny nose, cough or have been in attendance at a potential exposure site.
  4. Ensure that any personal equipment – whistles, cards, water bottles, etc. are NOT be shared under any circumstances.
  5. Arrive to the field no earlier than 20 minutes before start time. Make sure that you are dressed in all appropriate attire and have equipment with you before going on the field.
  6. Wait until officials from the previous match have left the technical bench before entering.
  7. A coin toss or other non-contact method will be held by the match officials with the two captains to determine starting ends.

## **DURING MATCH**

1. Teams will take the field ready for commencement of play:
  - There will be no fair play handshake. Fist pumps, elbow taps are acceptable.
  - Ensure teams are practising social distancing during team line up in the centre of the field.

## **POST-MATCH**

1. Avoid shaking hands with players, coaches, and other officials after a game. Suitable alternatives include elbow tap, nods, etc.
  2. Vacate the technical bench within 10 minutes once the game concludes and all official duties have been completed to allow the officials for the next game to enter.
