- We acknowledge that a successful application requires the club (and its officers) to extend full support to the player to ensure they can fully participate and compete at the required level.
- The Association at its discretion may review its support for the player's exemption if it is deemed:
 - the player's club fails to undertake its responsibilities; or
 - the player is not equipped physically, emotionally or psychologically to play in this grade.
- The club JLC representative will present a detailed update of the progress of this player at the first JLC Meeting that takes place after the first round of LWA fixtures, as part of their club report. They will also provide a report of that player's experience at the conclusion of the regular season to the JLC.
