International Players Code of Ethics

The Lacrosse WA supports in principle the concept of international players and their value to lacrosse. Their reputation can enhance the standing of the game in the community.

The Lacrosse WA will not favourably view matters that may bring it into disrepute within the community.

Clause 8 (1) of the LWA Constitution states:

Suspension or expulsion

a) *The board may decide to suspend a member's membership or to expel a member from Lacrosse WA if:*

- i. the member contravenes any of these rules; or*
- ii. the member acts detrimentally to the interests of Lacrosse WA.*

eg: published accounts bringing lacrosse into disrepute or any misdemeanour under the terms of the visa.

A **temporary work visa** allows individuals to work in a foreign country for a specific period. Here are some details about temporary work visas in **Australia**:

1. **Australia**:

- **Temporary Work (Short Stay Specialist) Visa (Subclass 400)**: This visa permits short-term work for specialized roles. [It doesn't require sponsorship but is valid for up to 6 months](#)¹.
- **Temporary Skill Shortage Visa (Subclass 482)**: [Requires sponsorship and allows skilled workers to work in Australia for up to 4 years](#)².
- **Temporary Graduate Visa (Subclass 485)**: Available for recent graduates who studied in Australia. [It allows work and residence for 18 months to 4 years, depending on qualifications](#)².
- **Skilled – Recognised Graduate Visa (Subclass 476)**: [For engineering graduates from recognized institutions, providing an 18-month stay](#)².
- **Skilled Regional (Provisional) Visa (Subclass 489)**: [Allows skilled workers to live and work in regional areas for up to 4 years](#)².
- **Business Innovation and Investment (Provisional) Visa (Subclass 188)**: [Requires sponsorship and is suitable for business owners and investors](#)².
- **New Regional Visas (Subclass 491 and Subclass 494)**: [Introduced in November 2019, these skilled regional provisional visas allow living and working in regional Australia](#)²
